
Monitoring the outcomes of the embedding process

Programming Phase

- Mapping of cooperation actions, including MRS embedding, by INTERACT (based on EC screening of ERDF programmes)
- Additional input from EUSDR Evaluations, NCs (e.g. Task Force EMB-DR) and managing/programming authorities (MA network meetings)

Implementation Phase

- Scanning calls for EUSDR relevance via <u>EuroAccess</u>
- Monitoring of projects via PAC Reporting Tool
- Monitoring of projects via managing/programming authorities (e.g. labelling of projects, extra points for project proposals with MRS relevance, a standing point at programme MC meetings?)
- Keeping track of programme evaluations

















Monitoring/Reporting

PAC Reporting (spring 2024)

- Via online reporting tool
- Progress and Achievements of the EUSDR Priority Areas, including questions from the EC

NC Reporting (spring 2024)

- Questionnaire directly from/to the EC
- Kind request to send a copy to DSP






Capacity Building

Development of a capacity building (CB) framework :

a Capacity Building Need Assessment (CBNA) is currently ongoing in order to develop a CB framework for the EUSDR core stakeholders in respect to their roles, responsibilities and collaboration relationships:

- **first phase (concluded):** collect data for a capacity building analysis using three methodological tools:
 - exploratory interviews (March/April 2024)
 - √ focus groups (April/May 2024)
 - questionnaires (May/June 2024)













Capacity Building

- Development of a capacity building (CB) framework :
 - second phase (concluded):
 - analyse data for a capacity building assessment
 - ✓ develop a framework for improving capacity building through tailored trainings.

→ From 2025 on: based on the CBNA, **five training** sessions will be provided for EUSDR core stakeholders















WHY Youth involvement

- propose concrete actions and projects and suggest topics
- bring ideas to the attention of high-level politicians from EUSDR states and regions
- contribute to the EUSDR priorities and policies, participate in events
- raise attention for the special features of their regions at the transnational level















Danube Youth Council (DYC): Involvement in PAs

- Professional background in the field of the PA is **not** a prerequisite.
- Possible ways of meaningful involvement:
 - Letting the DYC members give their input on documents, projects, processes...
 - Involving the DYC members in drafting reports, studies, agendas...
 - Inviting the DYC members to meetings, conferences, events and (if possible) giving them an active role

Mutually beneficial exchange

PAs shall profit from gaining new, fresh perspectives/inputs

DYC members shall profit from gaining an insight into the daily work of the Strategy, making their voices heard and bringing in the perspective(s) of the young people











DYC current developments



second **DYC mandate** year **ended on 31 October 2024** (one-time 50% of DYC members remain – WP as of 02.2024).



Peer learning, transfer of knowledge and inclusion of the new members as a crucial task within the DYC (a concept for this was elaborated by the DYC at the 3rd Danube Youth Camp, 27-29 October 2024, Vienna)

• Kind request to PACs/teams to be patient with the new members while they learn the ropes ©



Meetings between PAs and (new) DYC members can be facilitated by the DSP (beginning of 2025).











DYC switch of members as of 1 November 2024



Approx. 18 experienced DYC members will remain for one more year; approx. 10 new ones will be appointed.



Call for Participation (closed): <u>application form</u> was open until mid-October for candidates from AT (1), BA (1), HR (1), CZ (1), DE (1, only BY), HU (1), MD (1), RS (1) and SK (2)



New members will choose PAs, depending on fields of interest, until end of 2024

DYC: Financing of SG meeting attendance

- Youth involvement as a horizontal priority in the 2023-2028 PAC projects
- The endorsed long-term DYC financing concept foresees that the **on-site participation of min. 1 selected DYC member in 1 SG meeting per PA per year** shall be funded via the PAC budgets (travel & accomm. costs for 1 person per year).
 - → Above that:
 - →Online participation of DYC-members in SG meetings
- In those cases where no budget for youth activities was foreseen at the time of the elaboration of the PAC projects, it is possible to shift budget or add additional budget!
- Online consultation with DRP was held on 8 March 2024 to clarify open questions

 report was sent to all PACs











Danube Youth Organisations Network (DYON)

- Open network, complementary structure to the DYC.
- Established in 2024, under the coordination of AT PCY.
- Provide framework for partnerships for joint projects and initiatives, exchange of good practices and experiences, and organisation of joint events.
- Exact setup, scope and activities of the DYON remain to be defined.
- Next DYON meeting scheduled for 30 September 2024.


