









Natural Gas Reverse Flows in the Danube Strategy Region: Current State and Outlook (2)


State of play:

- Differences among prices



- Optimistic scenario



Obstacles:

Reccommendations (Regulation):

- Market Liberalisation.
- Do not link natural gas contracts to other arrangements with Russia.
- Cut the influence of energy incumbents on public policies.
- Support non-EU partners in adopting the EU legislation.

Natural Gas Reverse Flows in the Danube Strategy Region: Current State and Outlook (6)

Reccommendations (Infrastructure):

- Consider direct or indirect form of support to projects that enhance diversity of sources of supply
- Insist on Russian projects' compliance with the EU regulatory framework.
- Support offshoots from the emerging Turkey-Greece-Albania-Italy trunk line.

Natural Gas Reverse Flows in the Danube Strategy Region: Current State and Outlook (7)

Reccommendations (Liquidity):

- Support the Turkey-Greece-Albania-Italy corridor
- Initiate intergovernmental negotiations with Middle Eastern, Central Asian, and Mediterranean suppliers.
- Support LNG terminal in Croatia
- Initiate dissolution of national incumbents.
