

HOW EASY WAS IT TO ENGAGE? WHICH OBSTACLES HAVE YOU HAD?

- ➤ Not each municipality has seen energy independence as important aspect but in former times: our region was next to "iron curtain" thus chance for regional development
- Fear and Knowledge:
 - in wind sector not given because we have been the first and involved people from the beginning on
 - first years: to less educated people in this field
- Financing: no tariffs, no support
- Regulations: usually we starting with innovative projects thus, no regulations exist
- Economical Decisions: only if it works in the long run (may first subsidies are gone)
- Newest one is enviousness: success is given thus high working load, failures and difficult decisions may not be seen



RESULTS AND BENEFITS FOR THE MUNICIPALITY / REGION

- Regional Identity: being proud of living in a region which is/become independent of foreign supply
- Reduction in energy costs: due to energy saving measurements, own renewable projects
- Tax / Project Income:
 - > EPK: 100 working places fix and up to 500 working places temporary
 - In addition: several other REN-Suppliers
 - Project Income: depending on kind of project and owner
- Keeping the "young ones at home" additional working places within the region due to additional companies starting economic activities in the region: for creating wind mills/PV/Biomass/Biogas-plants, REN-suppliers building construction halls, other sectors are coming due to "prosporing regional development"

- > ... you focus on cooperation instead of competition
