EUSDR Strategic Projects : Overview process & timeline

- Strategic Project (SP) concept definition process started;Coordination process with the EC/DG REGIO;
- SP draft concept presented for debate & feed-back with the PACs;
 EUSDR SP Data Sheet developed;
 - SP concept & the accompanying Data Sheet reviewed;
 - NCs/PACs endorsed the final EUSDR SP concept/Data Sheet;
 - DSP received "green light" to lead the selection process;
- mid- March mid-May 2016
- S mid-May -June 2016
- **Sept. 2016**

- 1st round of the selection process launched;
 PAs (PACs, SG) invited to identify and submit DSP potential SPs;
- Screening process of the received projects by the DSP ongoing !!! Feed back comments & meetings with the concerned PAs:
- Feed-back, comments & meetings with the concerned PAs;
- 1st round of the selection process completed;
- DSP provides the NCs with the outcome of the screening process;
- NC to decide on the granting of the EUSDR Strategic Projects label;

> *post-Sept 2016*

- 2nd round of the selection process to be launched .

EUSDR Strategic Projects - Purpose

Purpose:

- To contribute to stronger and clearer strategic focus to the EUSDR PA's activities;
- To further encourage joint cooperation between Danube states/regions introducing more <u>strategic focus;</u>
- To establish <u>strategic ground for projects/processes</u> to be considered in 2015/2016 revision process (EUSDR targets, actions, milestones, roadmaps);
- To strengthen and improve <u>communication</u> on the strategic focus and efforts of the EUSDR;
- Could serve as pilot examples for possible strategic support for <u>embedding projects in</u> <u>funding programs/sources</u>.





EUSDR Strategic Projects : Scope & Criteria

Scope :

- In terms of structure:
 - 1) Single project, contributing to a PA and/or PAs;
 - 2) Group of projects, contributing to a PA and/or PAs;
 - 3) Process (e.g. network, new cooperation mechanism, etc.), contributing to a PA and/or PAs;
- In terms of readiness:

1) Preparatory projects 2) Investment projects

Criteria:

- (1) it clearly contributes to a EUSDR Target;
- (2) it clearly and substantially supports a EUSDR Action;
- (3) it has evident and high Macro-Regional dimension (at least 3 Danube countries/regions);
- (4) it is approved/supported widely by the Danube countries;
- (5) it is realistic in terms of objectives, activities, timeframe and results;
- (6) it has clear financial plan, clearly linked to SP activities, timeframe, deliverables.





Brief Overview : Main actors and tasks

EUSDR PAs (PACs and SG Members)

- identify potential strategic processes/projects;
- prepare an EUSDR Strategic Project Data Sheet for each of the processes/projects identified;
- submit the identified projects in the required format (SP Data Sheets) & by the agreed deadline.

Danube Strategy Point (DSP)

- carries out the screening process against the set criteria;
- provides feedback, comments to the relevant PAs;
- ensures coordination with the EC/DG REGIO throughout the selection process;
- provides the NCs with the final outcome of the screening process, and
- proposes the projects to be considered for final validation & approval.

EUSDR National Coordinators (NCs)

- endorse the outcome of the selection process;
- decide on granting the EUSDR Strategic Project/Process label.





CEUSDR Strategic Projects identification and selection - rolling process

Sept. 2016 - 2nd round of the selection process

• Tentative deadline for projects submission –end-2016

SP to keep PACs informed about further developments.
