

SEED MONEY FACILITY CALL (SMF)

- Launch: 27 November by Danube Region Programme
- A tool for kick-starting development of strategic projects and large-scale initiatives for the EUSDR
- The projects later on can be financed by any other financing instrument
- Through the SMF applicants can develop projects that are addressing the EUSDR action plan
- Project duration: 12 months
- Budget: max 62 500 EUR with 80% co-financing
- Partnership: min 2, max 5 financing partners from min 2 EUSDR countries
- Max 3 projects/priority area, the PAs will be involved into the dissemination, evaluation and implementation of the projects
